Re: Video Gaming Terminal License Update

Staff was asked to look at what we charge in comparison to other communities for a terminal fee. Currently, the Village of Bartlett charges a fee of \$250 per machine in the first year and \$500 per machine every year after to the establishment. The vendor is required to have a village sticker on each machine. The village then keeps those numbers on file. Non-home rule communities are capped by the State at \$25.

The Village of Bartlett has the authority to mandate that the terminal operator be responsible for paying a portion of the terminal fee as a part of their terminal operator license, which would take the burden of a raised fee off of the businesses. Staff is recommending the fee be raised to a total of \$1,000 split between the terminal operator (\$750) and the establishment (\$250). Currently, terminal operators and establishments split 65% of the total revenue 50/50 and the village receives 5% of the total revenue.

The chart below outlines the total revenue to the establishment and terminal operator as well as the revenue brought to the village by each business:
