Chief Ullrich advised of the top three (3) candidates on the Police Sergeant Eligibility List:

 - 4) Christopher Johnson
 - 5) Mireya Flores

Chief Ullrich advised he recommends the top candidate on the list. A brief discussion occurred amongst the Board members in regard to the top candidates.

<u>COMMISSIONER SAMPEY MOVED</u>, second by Commissioner McGuire to provide a conditional offer to Officer Brian Simone for the position of sergeant.

5. Discussion of revisions to the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Fire and Police Mr. Powers was contacted via cellular phone at approximately 4:14 p.m. to discuss the revision of the Boards Rules and Regulations.

Deputy Chief Pretkelis informed the Board members there are items that need to be updated within the Rules and Regulations and asked the Board to please also consider incorporating a lateral police officer hiring process. In a previous meeting on May 21, 2020, a lateral police officer hiring process was discussed with Attorney John Broihier, however, the process was not included in the budget at that time. Deputy Chief Pretkelis informed the Board members the current budget now includes funds for the process.

Chief Ullrich and Deputy Chief Pretkelis both explained a lateral police officer hiring process is imperative given the current climate as well as attempting to stay ahead of filling projected openings. A discussion ensued in regard to the importance of having a lateral police officer hiring process and the steps that would need to be taken to implement the process.

Deputy Chief Pretkelis informed the Board members that Mr. Powers has written other department's lateral police officer hiring processes and will be assisting regarding this matter. A discussion ensued amongst all members and Mr. Powers in regard to the different options available. At the end of the discussion, it was determined the Board members would review the information provided and will discuss this topic at the next regularly scheduled meeting on September 07, 2021, which will be attended by Mr. Powers.
