



REQUIREMENTS

- Sprinkler heads are not permitted in the Village Right of Way.
- The **contractor** performing the work **shall be registered with the Village of Bartlett** as a **licensed irrigation contractor** and the **plumbing contractor shall be registered with the Village of Bartlett.**
- Provide a current copy of all licenses.
- Contractor shall have a licensed CCCDI on staff for the RPZ test and certification.
- Any lawn sprinkler connected to a potable supply shall be equipped with a reduced pressure principle backflow preventer assembly (RPZ). The RPZ may be located outside provided it conforms with Section 890.1130(g)(1) of the Illinois State Plumbing Code.
- A licensed plumber shall inspect every sprinkler system installed and shall make the physical connection between a sprinkler system and a backflow prevention device.

WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY

- A completed digital application at the Village of Bartlett website (<https://www.bartlett.il.gov>)
- The type of backflow protection and type of pipe used.
- A copy of the signed contract.
- Plat of survey showing the location of the sprinkler heads (with make, model, quantity, and type of pipe used) RPZ, rain sensor, controller and type of pipe being used.
- Permit fee (see chart below) plus \$75.00 plumbing review fee.

Estimated Cost of the Project	Permit Fee
Less than \$500.00	\$40.00
\$500.00 but less than \$1,000.00	45.00
\$1,000.00 but less than \$2,500.00	50.00
\$2,500.00 but less than \$5,000.00	60.00
\$5,000.00 but less than \$10,000.00	90.00
\$10,000.00 or more	12.00 per thousand

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- No work can begin until a building permit has been issued.**
- A final inspection is required** upon completion of work.
- Contact the Building Division at 630-540-5920 or log on through the portal at least 48 hours in advance to request an inspection.
