The 2018 Strategic Plan



The 2018 Strategic Plan was approved by the Village Board at the January 16 meeting. This new plan involved input from a variety of stakeholders within the community, including civic groups, other taxing bodies, business groups, residents and Village staff.

This Strategic Plan prioritizes the goals for the community into four categories -- short-term routine; short-term complex; long-term routine; and long-term complex. The plan will act as a road map for the Village going forward and department heads will incorporate this vision into day-to-day operations and the budget.

Short-Term Routine - 1 to 3 Years

1. Enhance public awareness via an education campaign to increase residents' awareness of Village services, activities, funding, etc.
2. Develop a multi-level "cascading" public information campaign on Lake Michigan water connection.
3. Enhance community events.

Short-Term Complex - 1 to 3 Years

4. Develop a business development strategy focused on attracting and incentivizing an additional grocery store to town.
5. Develop a business recruitment strategy to attract developers to invest in the downtown area and provide options for businesses to locate to Bartlett.
6. Undertake a comprehensive review of building permit and development process.
7. Complete necessary infrastructure requirements for full Lake Michigan water conversion.
8. Maintain fiscal position and budget stability.
9. Develop a strategy to attract/locate a hotel/motel in the Village.
10. Develop strategies for development of Railroad Avenue vacancies.
11. Develop community branding plan.
12. Work to improve retail business profile in the Village.
13. Revisit, refine and execute the Village's overall economic development incentives.
14. Maintain or enhance Village standards for service delivery.

Long-Term Routine - 3 to 5 Years

15. Improve Village bike and pedestrian pathways and routes.
16. Examine service delivery methods and approaches.
17. Maintain and enhance the Village's fiscal profile and financial strength.

Long-Term Complex - 3 to 5 Years

18. Develop a long-term plan to refurbish/rebuild the Village's sewage treatment plant.
19. Develop a strategy to identify and complete roadway improvement and traffic mitigation programs and design.
20. Develop an overall Village-wide technology master plan.
21. Redevelop/revitalize sites along Lake Street and Route 59.
22. Work with IDOT to improve traffic safety along Route 59.
23. Develop a strategy to redevelop the lot on Lake Street and Route 59.

Timeout with the Trustees

This Village Board recently approved the capital budget for the next five-year period and, as anticipated, a significant portion of the 2018-2019 budget focuses on infrastructure improvements needed for Bartlett's transition to 100% Lake Michigan water by 2019, when its water contract with the City of Elgin expires.

The Village currently purchases approximately 60% of its water from Elgin with the balance of the source water pumped from Village wells. However, last February the Board finalized an agreement to join the DuPage Water Commission and purchase Lake Michigan water through this membership.

Some of the infrastructure additions and improvements needed for this transition include a DuPage Water Commission receiving station, new elevated tower and ground storage tank and new transmission mains. A complete upgrade will be needed at the Lake Street pump station and piping/valve modifications will be needed at the Main Street and Stearns Road pump stations to make them compatible and functional with the new water system.

We will be seeing construction of local water transmission lines this summer, running along the Stearns Road right-of-way.

After several years of discussion and planning, we are happy to now be moving forward with this water project and to soon be able to deliver high quality, softened Lake Michigan water to Village residents. We are also pleased to start 2018 with some exciting news about the project.

First, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has awarded a one-time \$485,000 Special Appropriation Act Program grant to the Village of Bartlett to help finance the water infrastructure project. This grant was made available through the USEPA annual appropriations process and was designated in 2009 for projects to improve drinking water infrastructure.

These funds will help the Village build the new pump station that is needed for connection to the DuPage Water Commission.

The Village received another piece of good news in January, when the DuPage Water Commission opened bids for the new water transmission main from Roselle. Benchmark Construction submitted the low bid of \$13.25 million, which was 20.7% below the engineer's estimate.

Since these improvements are mainly funded through water rates, we are very pleased to be able to offset even a small portion of the cost of such a major capital project through fiscally responsible bids and grants.

Flood

FLOOD HAZARD AREAS

The Village of Bartlett has some floodplain areas. On the northwest side of town is the Brewster Creek Tributary. In the middle of town there is some floodplain in the Wayne Grove Forest Preserve. The northeastern part of the Village has the Brewster Creek floodplain, which flows to the West Branch of the DuPage River floodplain.

Information on whether your property is in the 100-year floodplain can be obtained by coming into the Village of Bartlett Building Department. Maps are available for viewing, as well as other flood-related information. Contact the Village of Bartlett Building Department, 630-837-0800 for further assistance.

NATURAL & BENEFICIAL FUNCTIONS

Floodplains play a valuable role in providing natural benefits to the Village of Bartlett and the surrounding area. Floodplains that are relatively undisturbed provide open spaces and aesthetic pleasure, as well as function for active processes, such as filtering nutrients.

Wayne Grove Forest Preserve and Hawk Hollow Forest Preserve floodplains are used to filter farm chemical runoff so that these areas can maintain biodiversity and ecosystem sustainability. Both floodplains contain historic and archeological sites that provide opportunity for education. Both enhance waterfowl, fish and other wildlife habitats and provide feeding/breeding grounds. And lastly, both floodplains provide natural erosion control and open space so further flooding damage does not occur.

FLASH FLOODS

Flash-flooding is the general type of flooding caused by heavy rain events. A flooding event can occur with 2 to 4 inches of rain in a 3 to 4 hour time period on some streets throughout the Village. Several detention areas may rise during these events. However, all of the Village streets are designed to additionally store stormwater for a period of time.

The Village experienced a record rain event in September of 2008; almost 9 inches of rain occurred in less than a 24-hour period. The Village has made several drainage improvements since then and is continually making improvements in the community.

DRAINAGE SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

As simple as it may sound, keeping smaller ditches and streams free of debris can dramatically improve the run-off capacity of low-lying areas and can greatly reduce the occurrence of blockage that significantly contributes to flooding.

It is illegal to dump materials into a required waterway and violators may be fined. If you see someone in the act of dumping or see debris in one of Bartlett's watercourses, please contact the Village Public Works Department at 630-837-0811.

Homeowners are responsible for maintaining their perimeter drainage swales. You may have a storm inlet in your yard; if you do, make sure to keep it clear of debris. If you have any flooding or drainage concerns on your property, the Village of Bartlett staff is available to assess your drainage

concerns. You can contact the Building Department at 630-837-0800.

PROPERTY PROTECTION MEASURES

If your property is susceptible to flooding, there are many flood damage reduction measures you can employ.

- Watertight seals can be applied to brick and block walls to protect against low-level flooding.
- Utilities, such as heating and air conditioning systems, water heaters and other major appliances can be elevated to higher floors in the structure or onto raised platforms.
- Temporary measures, such as moving furniture and other valuables to higher floors or sand-bagging exterior openings, will also help.
- Elevating or relocating the entire structure may also be a feasible option.

FLOODPLAIN PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

All development within the 100-year floodplain (not just construction of buildings, but filling, excavation, fences, etc.) requires a Village development permit. Applications must be made prior to doing any work in a floodplain area.

Please contact the Village Building Department, 630-837-0800, to receive all the information you need to properly develop in the floodplain. You may report any illegal development activities to the above number as well.

FLOOD INSURANCE

If you do not have flood insurance, talk to your insurance agent. Most homeowner insurance policies do not cover damage from floods. Flood

insurance is only available to communities participating in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). Because of Bartlett's floodplain management programs, which attempt to protect property owners from multiple flooding hazards, the Village is part of the NFIP. Bartlett residents are able to obtain flood insurance. Additionally, because the Village participates in FEMA's CRS program, flood insurance premiums are discounted.

Be sure to check your policy to ensure you have adequate coverage. Typical policies cover the building structure, but not the contents. Contents coverage can also be obtained by asking.

There is a 30-day waiting period before flood insurance coverage becomes effective. Plan ahead; do not wait until a flood is predicted before purchasing flood insurance. If you are building inside the floodplain and are using a federally regulated lender/bank for a loan, the purchase of flood insurance is mandatory.

SUBSTANTIAL IMPROVEMENT/DAMAGE

If the cost of improvements to a building or the cost to repair damages (from any cause) to a building exceeds 50% of the market value of the building (excluding land value), the NFIP requires that the entire building be brought up to current floodplain management standards. Building improvement projects include exterior and interior remodeling, rehabilitation, additions and repair and reconstruction projects. Please contact the Village of Bartlett

FLOOD WARNING SYSTEM

Many times, flooding of streets and parking lots in Bartlett can be predicted, allowing ample time for preparation and evacuation. However, in the event of a flash flood due to a large rain event, there may only be hours to execute a plan.

Once the Bartlett Police and Bartlett Fire Protection District are notified of an oncoming flood event, the Village's Emergency Alert System will be activated. The Village can send a Code Red or mass emergency notification

system alert to the entire Village or a specific neighborhood. Community alerts and additional safety information will also be posted to the Village website and cable television station.

FLOOD SAFETY

The following commonsense guidelines can protect you from the dangers of flooding:

- Do not drive through a flooded area. More people drown in cars than anywhere else. Do not drive around barriers.
- Do not walk through flowing water. Currents can be deceptive. Six inches of water can knock you off your feet.
- Stay away from power lines and electrical wires. If your house is about to be flooded, turn off the power at the service box. Electrical current can travel through water. Electrocutation is the second leading cause of death during floods.
- Be alert to gas leaks. Turn off the gas to your house before it floods. If you smell gas, report it to the Fire Protection District, the Village or your gas company. Do not use candles, lanterns or open flames if you smell gas or are unsure if your gas has been shut off.
- Keep children away from flood waters, ditches, culverts and storm drains. Flood waters can carry unimaginable items that have dislodged themselves. Culverts can suck in smaller people, rendering them helpless.
- Clean everything that has been wet. Flood water is contaminated with sewage and other chemicals, which pose severe health threats.
- Look out for animals, especially snakes. Small animals that have been flooded out of their home may seek shelter in yours.
- Do not use gas engines, such as generators, or charcoal fires indoors during power outages. Carbon monoxide exhaust can pose serious health hazards.

IRS Income Tax Telephone Scam

It's tax season, and the Bartlett Police Department once again is warning residents about an IRS income tax telephone scam that is frequently reported during this time of year.

The scam involves callers claiming to be IRS agents or from the U.S. Treasury Department.

They tell you there is a problem with your tax return or ask about money owed for back taxes. The con artists will then demand immediate payment with a prepaid debit card, an iTunes gift card, a prepaid Green Dot MoneyPak card or a wire transfer, such as Western Union.

Please be aware that the IRS will always contact you first by mail or by a personal visit from field agents. The IRS never asks for credit card, debit card or prepaid card information over the phone. Do not fall for this type of scam, and do not give out any of your personal information to callers.

Did You Know?

...that Bartlett Police Department now offers residents the convenient option to request overnight parking and vacation watches online at www.frontlinepss.com/bartlett. Simply click the submit button and enter your information into Frontline Public Safety Solutions. Residents can still request overnight parking and vacation watches by calling the police non-emergency number, 630-837-0846 or complete the Vacation Watch form (available on the Village website) and return it to the Police Department Records Section.

Please be aware that the Police Department Vacation Watch house checks are considered only when the home is vacant for a minimum of three days and a maximum of two weeks per watch. If someone is staying at the premises in the homeowner's absence, a vacation watch will not be granted. In addition, apartment buildings, condominiums and houses that are for sale are not eligible for the Vacation Watch program.

A homeowner can request a maximum of one month total of vacation watches per calendar year at a residence. Vacation Watch requests that exceed more than one month total during a calendar year will be denied.

Submitting this request does not remove your responsibility as a homeowner from making every attempt to protect your property while you are away (securing doors/windows, lights on timers, stopping mail/newspaper service, etc.). Also, keep in mind that the Bartlett Police Department will make every effort to check your property, but only as priority calls or call volume allows.

50/50 Parkway Tree Program


Through its long-running Parkway Tree Program, the Village of Bartlett, with the help of homeowners, has planted trees to reforest and diversify Bartlett's parkways. This 50/50 shared program provides the opportunity for residents to select and purchase a parkway tree, with the Village contributing 50 percent of the cost.

All trees available for order are 2-inches in diameter. The cost for residents per tree is \$100, which includes planting, mulching and a one year warranty. Limited quantities of each species are available, and all orders are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. Due to the need for tree diversification, the Village will not be planting any maple species this year.

You are only eligible to purchase a tree if you had a tree removed from your parkway or have the space for one to be planted. Planting is only done in the parkway, not on private property. Trees must be spaced 30 to 40 feet apart. Other restrictions, such as proximity to driveways, street lights, hydrants, storm sewers, etc. may occur. Final planting locations will be determined by the Village.

Public Works will begin taking orders on February 19, 2018 for the spring planting season. Visit the Public Works page on the Village website, www.village.bartlett.il.us, on or after this date to see the available tree species and photos. Orders, with checks made payable to the Village of Bartlett, must be received by April 30, 2018. Please mail orders to: Parkway Tree Program, Bartlett Public Works, 1150 Bittersweet Dr, Bartlett, IL 60103.

The Village will not be offering this program in the fall, so this will be your only opportunity to have a parkway tree planted in 2018.



Changes to Brush Collection



Starting this spring, Groot Industries' brush collection will replace the Bartlett Public Works brush collection program. Brush collection will begin in April and continue through November.

Here are some changes to the program that you need to know:

- ~ Groot will collect brush weekly, April through November, instead of just two times per month
- ~ Brush pickup will be on Tuesday, the same day as the Village garbage/recycling pickup
- ~ The brush **must be bundled** no larger than 2 feet by 2 feet by 4 foot long and no heavier than 50 pounds

The brush program is intended for tree branches and shrubbery. You can dispose of any small twigs and other yard waste in generic yard waste bags with a sticker attached to the bag (stickers can be purchased in local retail stores, at Village Hall or by mail from Groot for \$2.50). If you still have labeled Republic Services yard bags, these can be used through the 2018 season.

"Over There, Over Here: Bartlett and the Great War" allows visitors to experience the heroics of Bartlett's 19 Yanks and the Village's homefront efforts during World War I through images, artifacts and first-hand accounts.

One of the images on display is this photo of Fred Staib, a gift from the Jeff Humbracht family to the Village of Bartlett Museums. Staib was one of the first Bartlett men to leave for service in WW I. After training stateside, he left for France in May 1918. As an ordnance sergeant, Staib's duties included dealing with the supply, repair and storage of arms, ammunition and other equipment.
