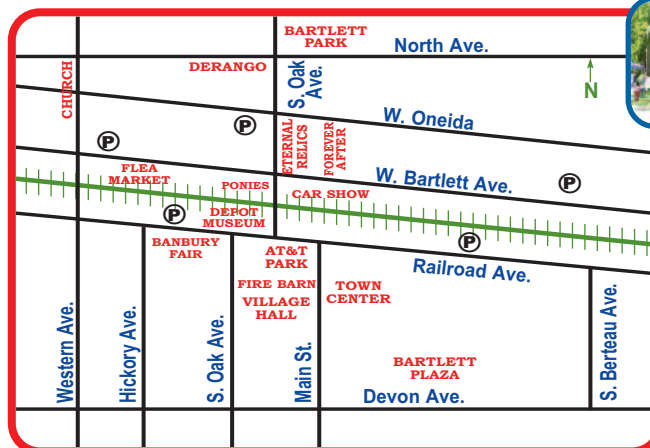

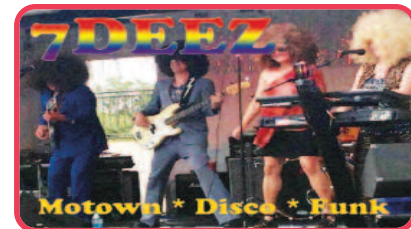

Join the free 45-minute tours as docents highlight buildings of historic and architectural interest. **New this year: Interesting and funny stories about events and people who once lived in Bartlett, plus a stop at Fire Station #1 to view the 1897 Howe Hand Pumper used by the Bartlett firemen from 1912 to 1929 and a 9/11 Memorial with a piece of steel recovered from the World Trade Center.**

Tours leave Bartlett Village Hall Saturday and Sunday promptly at Noon, 1:30, 2:45 and 4. Free with a Heritage Days button. Reserve your seat with a ticket from the Information Table in Village Hall parking lot, starting at 11 on Saturday and Sunday. Arrive 10 minutes before your tour, as empty seats will be filled with standbys at 5 minutes before each tour.

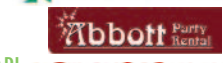
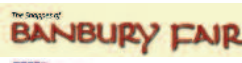
